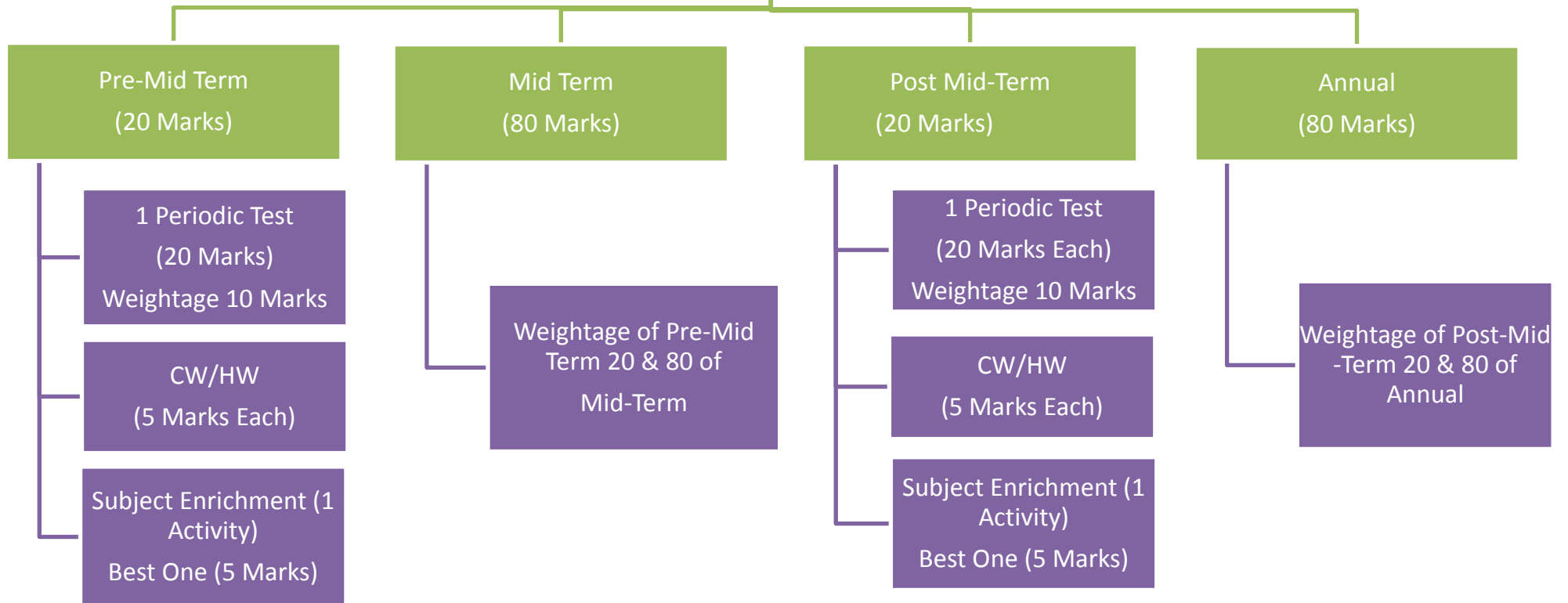


## EXAMINATION PATTERN

Exam (III to X)



### **Portion for Annual Examination**

- 1. Portion of Annual examination will not include the portion taught for Half Yearly examination. (STD- III to STD-V)**
- 2. 10% of 1<sup>st</sup> term (Mid-Term). Only significant topics for STD – VI.**
- 3. 20% of 1<sup>st</sup> term (Mid-Term). Only significant topics for STD – VII.**
- 4. 100% syllabus for STD – IX & X.**

### **Pre-Board test for Std IX & X.**

# There will be four written examinations, namely – Pre-Mid Term, Mid Term, Post-Mid Term and Annual Examination.

# Pre-Mid Term and Post-Mid Term assessment carry 20 marks.

i) Pen & Paper - 10 marks

ii) HW/CW - 5 marks

iii) Subject Enrichment Activity - 5 marks

*\* Subject Enrichment activities include ASL, Speech, Dictation, Recitation, Lab-activity, Role Play, MCQ, VSQ, Map work, Chart making, Skill Tests, Project work, etc.*

# Half Yearly and Annual Examination will be of 80 marks.

# A student has to secure minimum 'D' grade (33-40%) in all the subjects for promotion to the next higher class.

# Minimum 75% attendance is a pre-requisite criterion for promotion to the next higher class.

# Students obtaining 'E' grade in any subject will have to appear the improvement test.
